A magnificent contrast of all the wonder of long lees age and the tension of malic acidity, this is a cuvee bursting with grand complexity of dried nectarine, nutmeg ginger, biscuits, honey roast almonds, even tertiary hints of pipe smoke, then pulling dramatically and refreshingly into a taut finish of glittering malic that lingers long and bright. Dosage is intricately integrated. It has the depth and complexity to handle a touch of phenolic bitterness on the finish.



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
