53% chardonnay, 47% pinot noir. None of it goes through mlf. 15% of it spends time in 5500 litre oak. It's a classy style of sparkling wine. A beautiful style. It's characterised by its elegance and by its length. Fresh biscuity flavours, some steel, some nectarine and subtle white peach. Bead is ultra fine and the flavours extend long through the mouth. Quite entrancing.
