# 2013 XANADU DJL CABERNET SAUVIGNON

90% cabernet sauvignon, the balance equal portions of cabernet franc and petit verdot. Blackcurrant is the prominent varietal marker on bouquet and palate, the more lifted and floral notes contributed (most likely) by the minor partners. A touch of green herb and toasty oak along with the modulating tannin completes an attractive package.

Margaret River cabernet with a little help from cabernet's family and friends. No quibbles. Solid cabernet at a reasonable price. Value is in the drinker's favour. It tastes of blackcurrant, gum leaf and gravel and keeps the show going from the start to the longish finish. No dips or dramas. It's well-structured, well-fruited and well made. Recommended.
