Deepish red colour with a touch of development in the rim, the bouquet black olive, smoke and tapenade, soy sauce even, with great flavour and intensity, power and elegance. It magically combines concentration and length with acrobatic poise. The flavour is utterly delicious, oak making a substantial input but not at all dominating. A top wine. Age has raised it to a higher level.
