The colour shows expected development, the bouquet and palate likewise. It is a very complex pinot, with dark spices, cedar and forest notes intertwined with its cherry and plum fruit. A nice dab of tannin completes an impressive wine.

Deep red. Smoke-accented raspberry, cherry and candied rose scents, along with hints of star anise and vanilla. Silky, sweet and broad on the palate, offering juicy red fruit and spicecake flavours that pick up a hint of cocoa powder on the back half.

Supple tannins add shape to a smooth, long finish that leaves behind sappy red berry liqueur and clove notes.
