Brilliant violet. Intense cherry, cassis, potpourri and licorice scents are energized by zesty minerality and a suave Indian spice nuance. Deep-pitched cherry and blue fruit flavours expand and become livelier with aeration, picking up hints of toasty oak spice and violet and showing excellent clarity. Finishes smooth, sweet and impressively long, featuring round, even tannins and a lingering suggestion of blueberry liqueur.



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
