71% sauvignon blanc, 27% semillon, 2% muscadelle, estate-grown, 60% destemmed and crushed, free-run juice fermented in tank with cultured yeast, 40% (predominantly sauvignon blanc) whole bunch-pressed, cloudy free-run juice wild-fermented in French oak (10% new) and lees-stirred for several months. The bouquet immediately tells you the complex vinification has worked brilliantly, with struck match aromas, the layered palate of utterly exceptional intensity, with fruit, oak and acidity welded together so tightly it's impossible (and irrelevant) to unpick them, the aftertaste staggeringly long and intense.

71% sauvignon blanc, 27% semillon, 2% muscadelle. Around 40% of the wine was wild fermented in French oak (10% new), if I'm reading correctly. This won't be released until May 2017. It sees the groove and plays straight along it. This white wine doesn't put a foot wrong. You can call out flavour of lemongrass and nectarine, citrus and even tropical fruit, but basically it presents as seamless and satisfying with both good texture and intensity.
